## WARNING

- \* Failure to follow these warnings and assembly instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- \* Read all instructions before assembling crib. **KEEP INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE USE.**
- \* Check this product for damaged hardware, loose joints, loose bolts or other fasteners, missing parts or sharp edges before and after assembly and frequently during use. Securely tighten loose bolts and other fasteners. **DO NOT** use crib if any parts are missing, damaged or broken. Ask your dealer or contact a customer service representative (address & phone number shown above) for replacement parts and instructional literature if needed. **DO NOT** substitute parts.
- \* Infants can suffocate on soft bedding. Never add a pillow or comforter. Never place additional padding under an infant.
- \* Stop using crib when child begins to climb out or reaches the height of 35 in. (89 cm).
- \* To reduce the risk of SIDS, pediatricians recommend healthy infants be placed on their backs to sleep, unless otherwise advised by your physician.
- \* **DO NOT** place crib near window where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- \* Strings can cause strangulation! **DO NOT** place crib with a string around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords. **DO NOT** suspend strings over a crib or attach strings to toys.
- \* To help prevent strangulation tighten all fasteners. A child can trap parts of the body or clothing on loose fasteners.
- \* If refinishing, use a non-toxic finish specified for children's products.
- \* When child is able to pull to standing position, set mattress to lowest position and remove bumper pads, large toys and other objects that could serve as steps for climbing out.
- \* Never use plastic shipping bags or other plastic film as mattress covers because they can cause suffocation.
- \* Replace teething rail if damaged or loose (if teething rail is provided for this model).
- \* **CAUTION: ANY MATTRESS USED IN THIS CRIB MUST BE AT LEAST 27-1/4 INCHES BY 51-5/8 INCHES (69CM BY 131CM) WITH A MINIMUM THICKNESS OF 4 INCHES (10CM) BUT NOT EXCEEDING 6 INCHES (15CM).**
- \* Infants can suffocate in gaps between crib sides and a mattress that is too small.
- \* Follow warnings on all products in a crib.

## **WARNING ENTRAPMENT / STRANGULATION HAZARD:**

- \* Infants have died in toddler beds from entrapment and strangulation.
- \* **NEVER** use bed with children under 15 months.
- \* **NEVER** place bed near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- \* The **TODDLER BED** or **DAY BED** is not intended for children under 15 months of age or over 50 pounds (22.7kg).
- \* If guardrails are used as the mattress containment means, guardrail(s) provided must be used to avoid the formation of a gap between the mattress and the bed that could cause an entrapment (when product is used as a **TODDLER BED** or **DAY BED**).
- \* **DO NOT** place **DAY BED** or **TODDLER BED** near windows where cords from blinds or drapes may strangle a child.
- \* **DO NOT** place items with a string, cord, or ribbon around a child's neck, such as hood strings or pacifier cords.
- \* **DO NOT** suspend strings over a **TODDLER BED** or **DAY BED** for any reason.

# NOTES

- \* Ensure all parts and components are present before beginning assembly.
- \* Assemble on soft, smooth surface to prevent damage to product finish.
- \* Phillips head screw driver is not included.
- \* DO NOT use power tools.
- \* CAUTION: Adult assembly required.
- \* Assembly will require two people.



**WARNING: Should this product become damaged, and/or components are broken or missing, DO NOT USE.**

## CARE AND CLEANING

Dust regularly with a soft, lint-free cloth to prevent soil build-up. A damp cloth may be used occasionally to clean surface. Dry immediately. Do not use any abrasives that may damage finish. Excessive exposure to sunlight and extreme changes in temperature and moisture can damage wood furniture.








If the crib is to be stored, store in cool dry place and carefully package all original hardware to protect from loss.

Check bolts/screws periodically and tighten them if necessary.






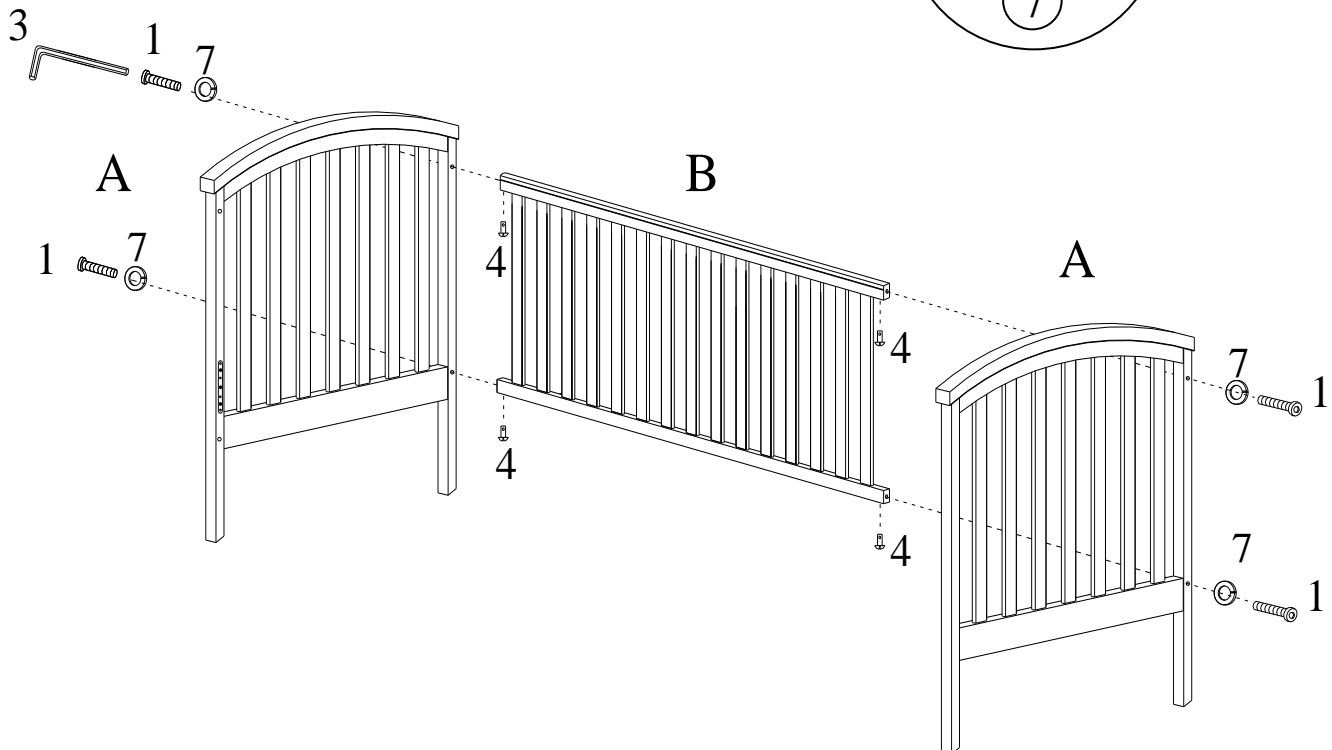
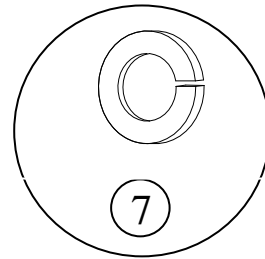
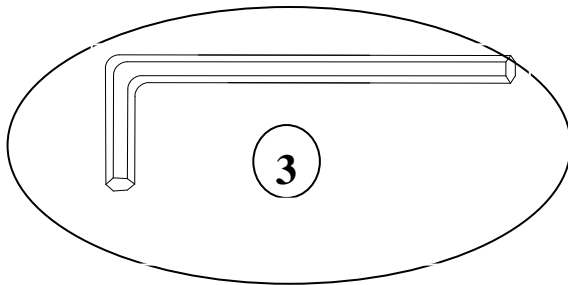
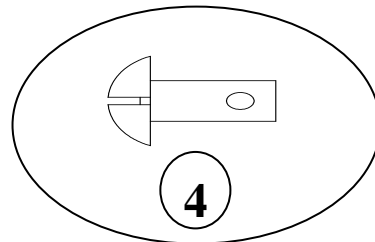
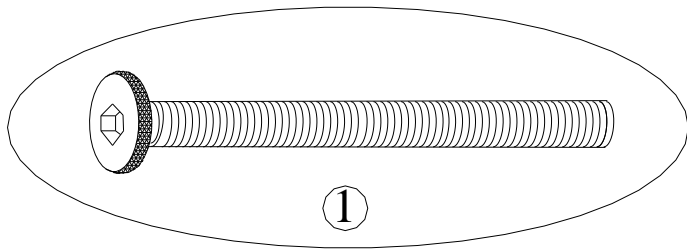
## CRIB ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

**NOTE: When inserting bolts, turn clockwise until tighten. Then loosen 1/2"-3/4" of a turn. After crib is completely assembled, return to each bolt and tighten. Use wax or soap on all bolts to facilitate assembly.**

## STEP 1

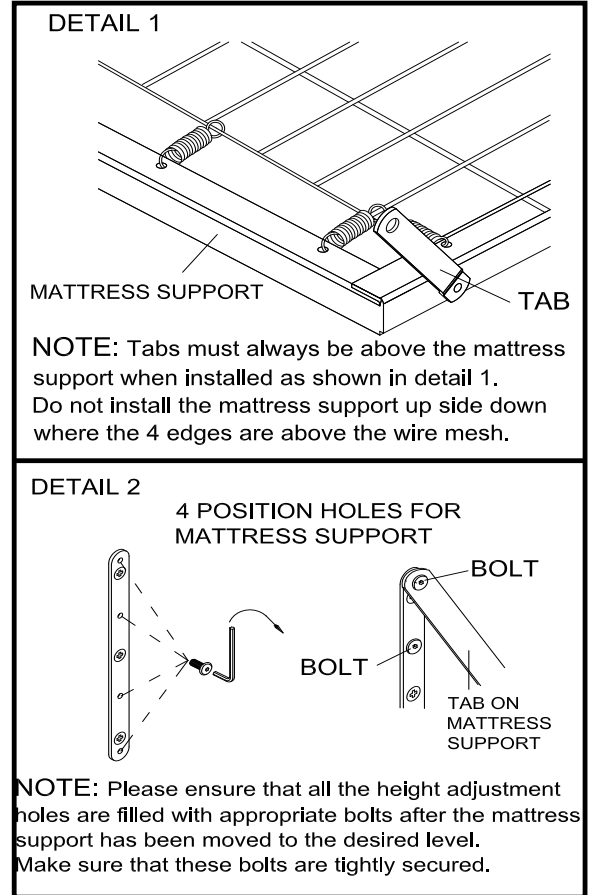
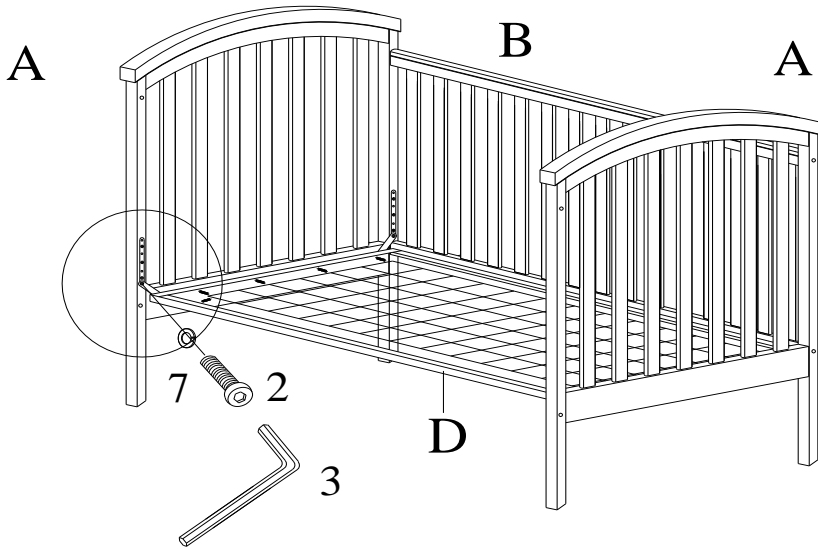
Attach left and right side frames (A) to stationary side (B) with hex socket head bolts (1), spring washers (7) and barrel nut (4) . Use Allen key (3) to tighten hex socket head bolts (1).

## STEP 2:

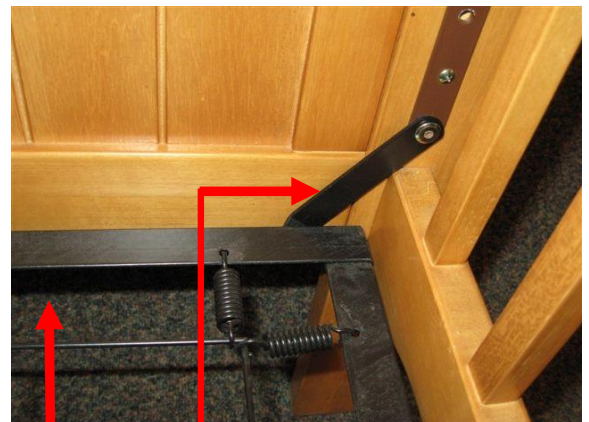
Attach mattress support (D) to the 4 corner posts with bolts (2) and spring washers (7). Use Allen Key (3) to tighten bolts. Refer to details 1 and 2 for direction on how to properly attach the mattress support.

## STEP 3

Attach left and right side frames (A) to stationary side (B) with hex socket head bolts (1), spring washers (7) and barrel nut (4). Use Allen key (3) to tighten hex socket head bolts (1).

## TODDLER BED & DAY BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: STARTING FROM CRIB

**STEP 1** Detach the stationary side (B) with 2 side frame (A) by Allen key (3).

**STEP 2** Move the mattress support (D) to the lowest position by unscrewing mattress support hex socket head bolts (2) using Allen key (3).

**STEP 3** Using Allen key (3), attach the TODDLER BED & DAY BED Guard rail (C) using hex socket head bolts (1), spring washer (7) gate pin (6), and barrel nuts (5) between 2 side frame (A) (see illustration).

**STEP 4** Tighten all screws clockwise.

## TODDLER BED & DAY BED ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS: STARTING FROM SCRATCH

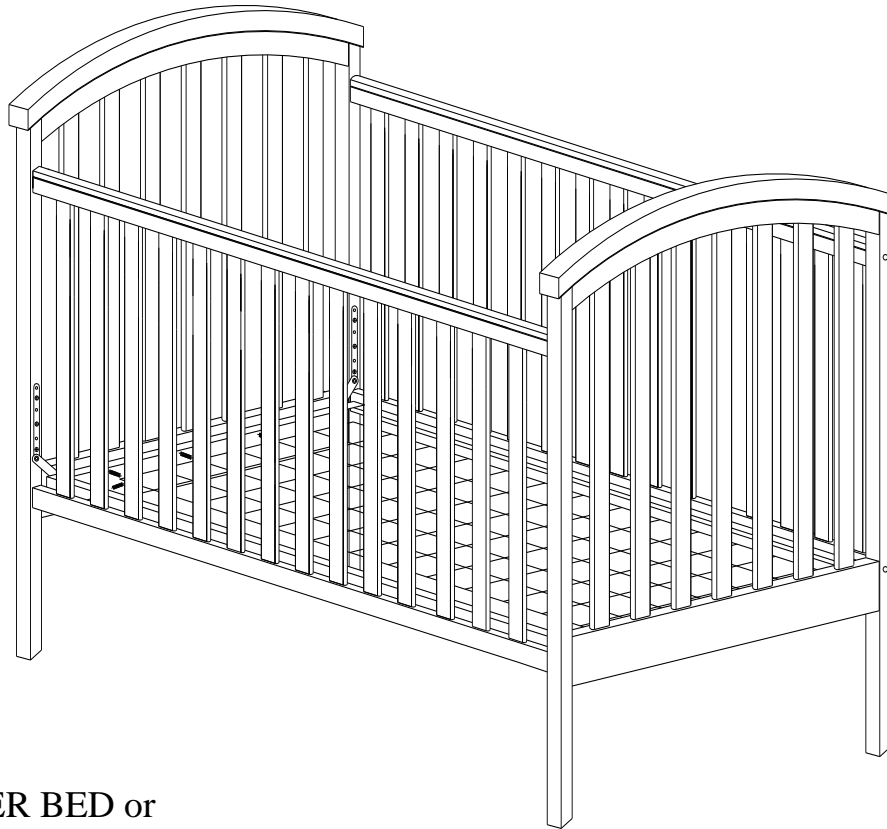
**STEP 1:** Follow step 1 to 2 of the crib assembly instruction.
